




































## **DISCUSSION**

Alveolar ridge surgery, as any invasive treatment should always be carefully evaluated in order to not compromise the success of the treatment.<sup>5</sup>

The goals of pre-prosthetic surgery are to create a better frame for the dentures to work, that would restore function, provide stability and retention, while preserving structures and satisfy esthetics.4

### CONCLUSION

Although anatomical conditions of the patient appeared to be unfavorable to achieving a mucous-bone denture without pre-prosthetic surgery, we took advantage of the maxillary alveolar conformation performing a satisfactory aesthetic and functional rehabilitation.
